By providing a public platform for publication, k@ta hopes to encourage global community to think more broadly, thoroughly, and analytically concerning issues in the study language, literature, and culture.

This journal was first published in 1999 and was nationally accredited in 2002, 2005, 2008, 2011, 2016, and 2020. It currently holds as a **Sinta 2** rank.
